
Our Mission

Sweet Dreams from Baby "D"

The *Sweet Dreams from Baby "D"* program was started in response to the unbelievable outpouring of support this organization has received since its inception. The program works to supply Halo™ Sleep Sacks to new parents, along with educational information on Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS) and rebreathing.



We provide Halo™ Sleep Sacks, which have been proven to reduce the risk of **SIDS**, to area hospitals. At the hospital, new babies are dressed in **sleep sacks** during their stay. Each baby is sent home from the hospital with a new sleep sack for use at home. Along with the sleep sacks, parents receive information on the prevention of **SIDS** and **rebreathing** as well as information on our program. We also sell sleep sacks to anyone wishing to purchase them. They include the educational information as well.

Rebreathing Carbon Dioxide and SIDS

Providing a safe sleeping area for your baby is one of the most important things you can do to ensure his safety. To eliminate as much risk as possible, babies should sleep in an approved crib with a firm mattress. There should be nothing around them that can restrict the flow of air.

It is especially imperative that new parents and caretakers understand why this is so important. All human beings exhale carbon dioxide. When a **baby sleeps** on his stomach or with objects in his crib, the carbon dioxide can build up around his head. These objects do not need to be in direct contact with a baby's face to cause carbon dioxide build up. A baby's nervous system is not developed enough to tell them to turn their head for this "bad air". They continue to breath "bad air" and can quickly succumb to carbon dioxide poisoning and die.

The cause of these deaths is not suffocation. To prevent rebreathing, always put your baby to bed on his back, with no blankets or other objects. It is believed that a fan in the room can **promote gentle air movement** and help as well. **Never allow your baby to sleep** in his car seat when not in the car because of risk of rebreathing and constricted air flow.
